

Global Immunization 1980-2013, DTP3 coverage






"Developing" countries with <u>all</u> districts achieving at least 80% DTP3 coverage, 2013



Progress in Polio Eradication, **Estimated and Reported Polio Cases, 1985-2013**












Countries Providing Vitamin A Supplementation, 2013

Number of countries having introduced HepB vaccine* and global infant HepB3 coverage, 1989-2013






Immunization coverage with 3rd dose of HepB vaccines in infants, 2013

Countries having introduced Hib vaccine in 1997 and 2013






Immunization coverage with PCV3 containing vaccines in infants, 2013


Immunization coverage with Rota containing vaccines in infants, 2013


Countries with a 3-5 year strategic plan for the national immunization system, 2013


Countries with a national annual work plan for immunization services, 2013
