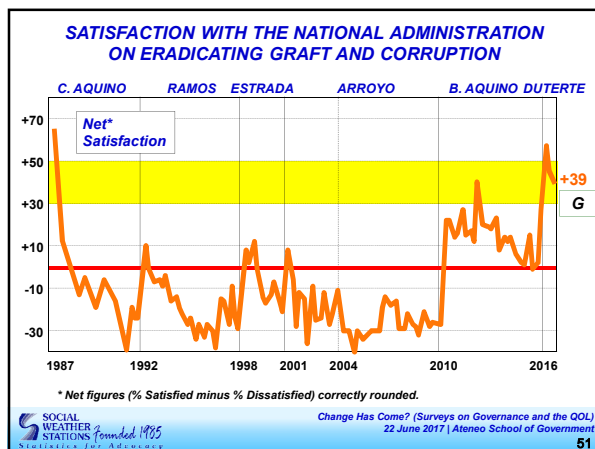
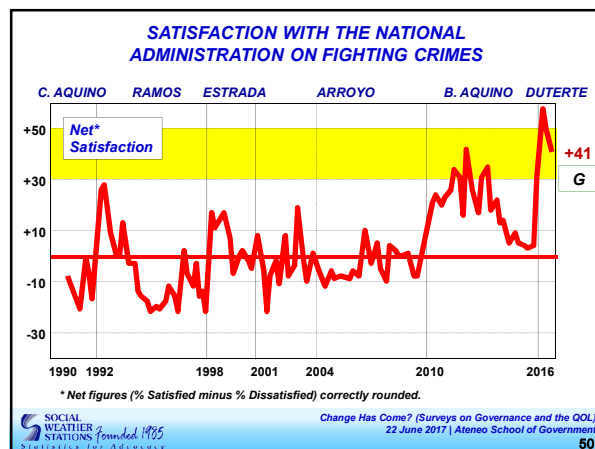
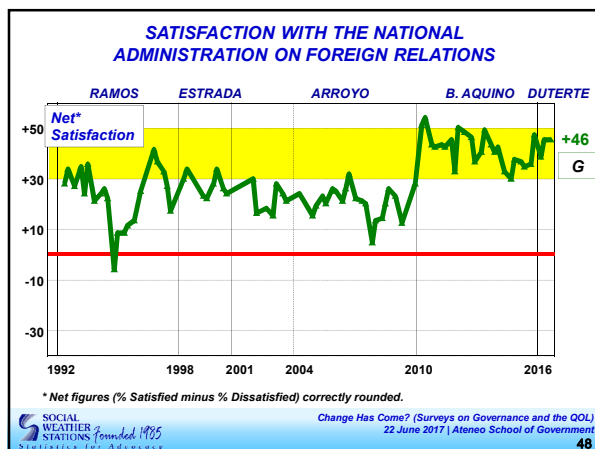
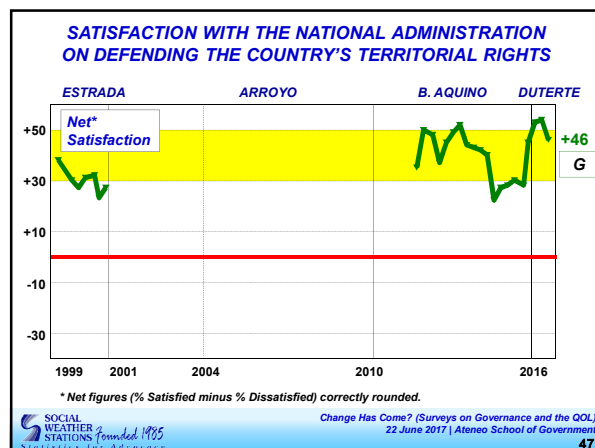
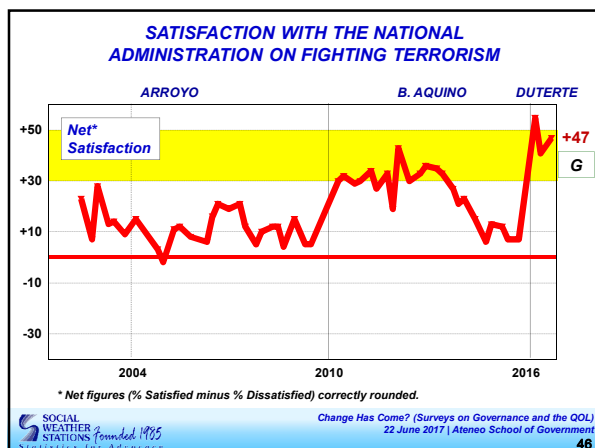


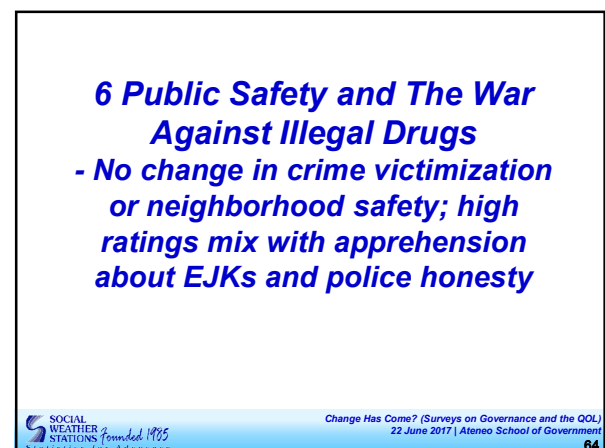
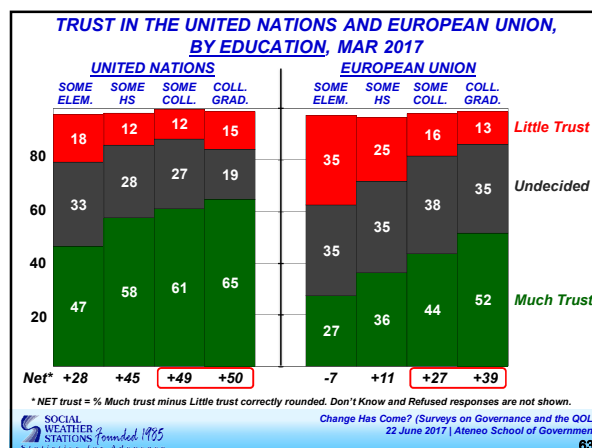
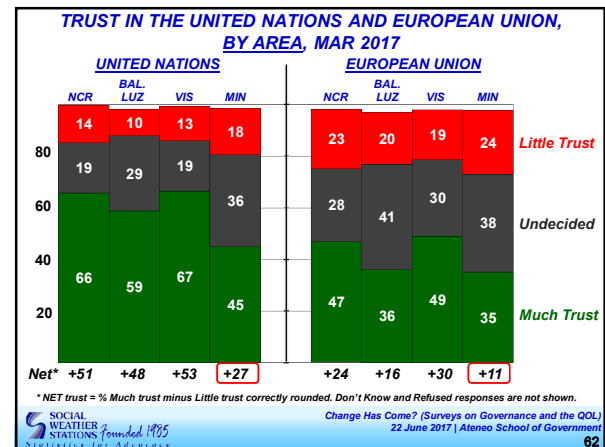
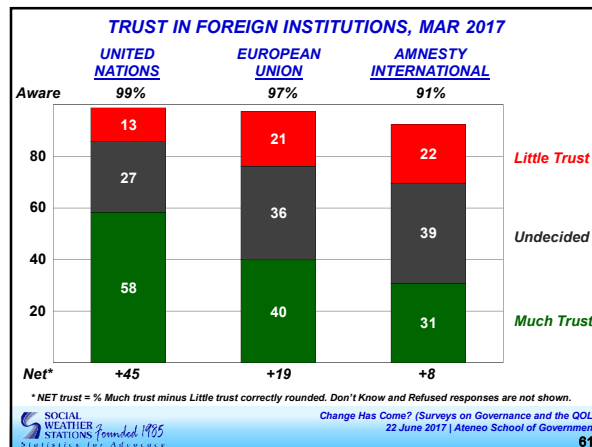
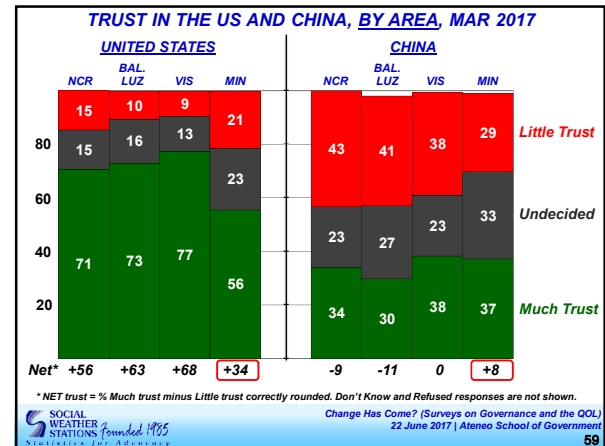
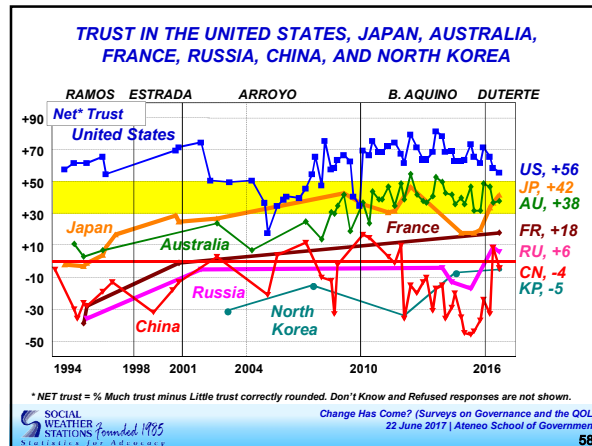




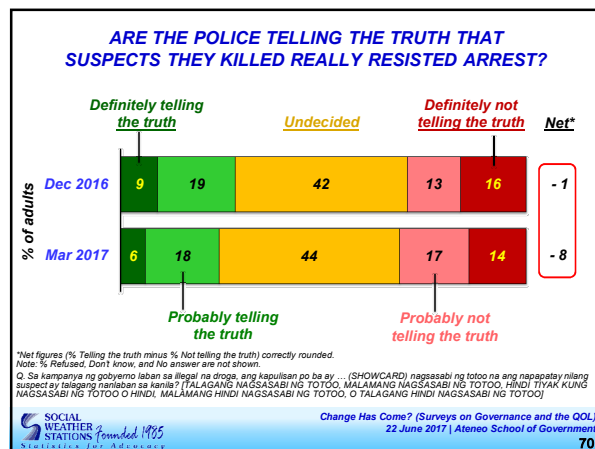
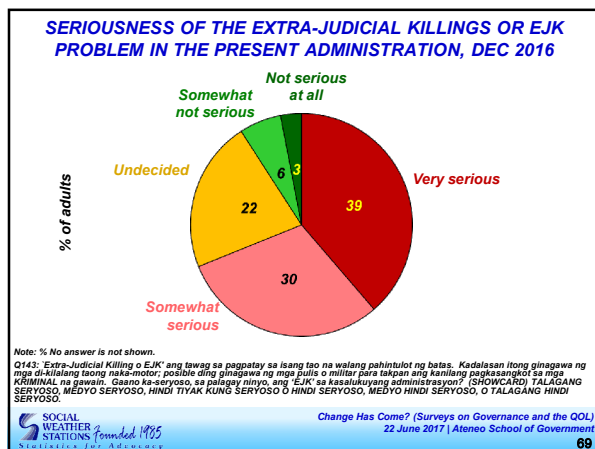
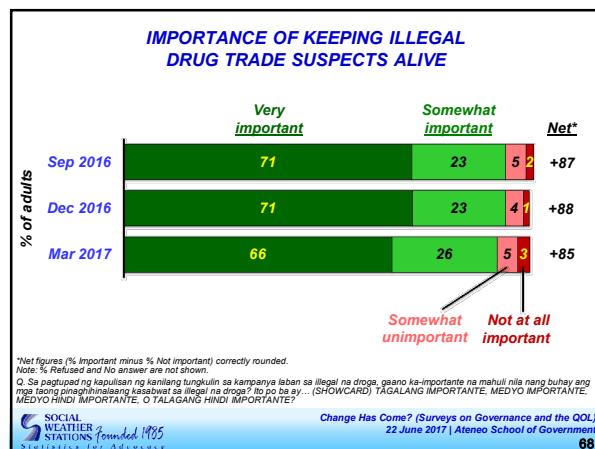
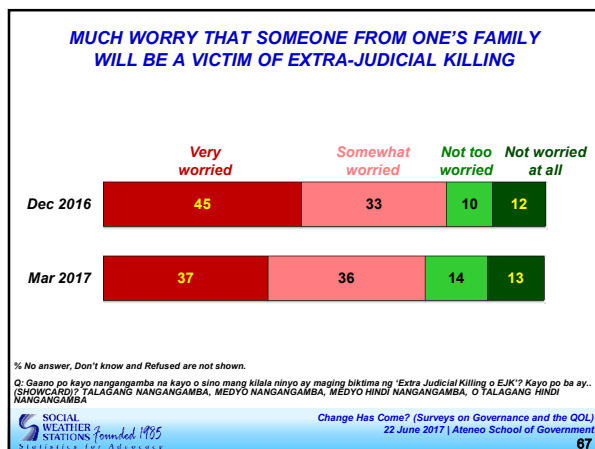
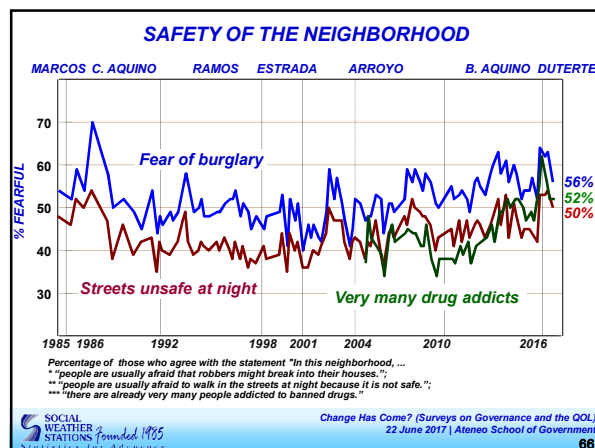
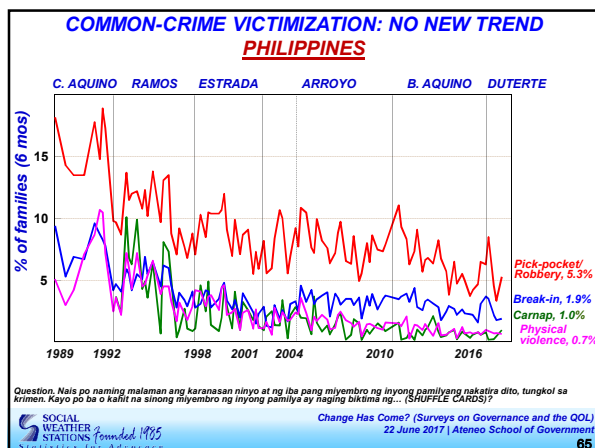


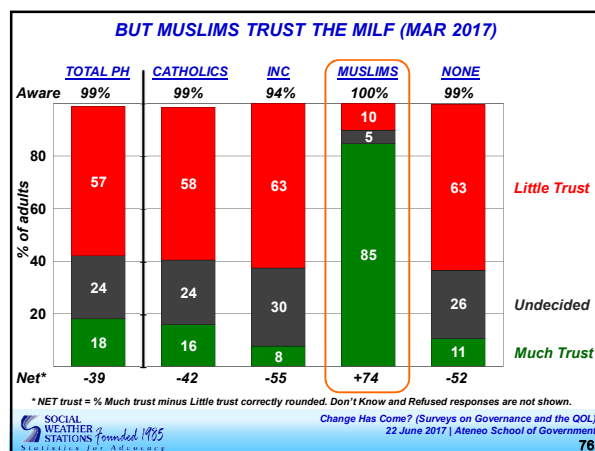
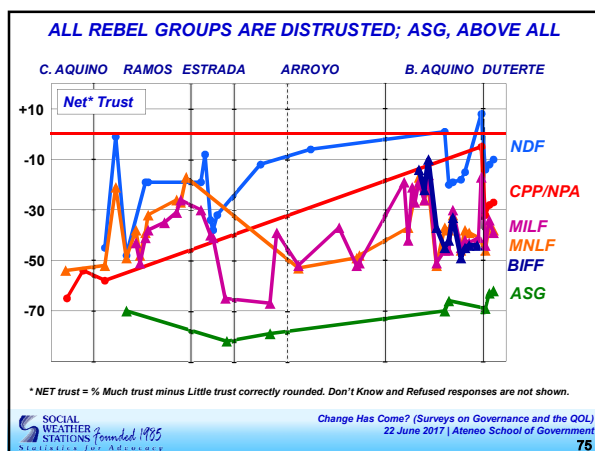
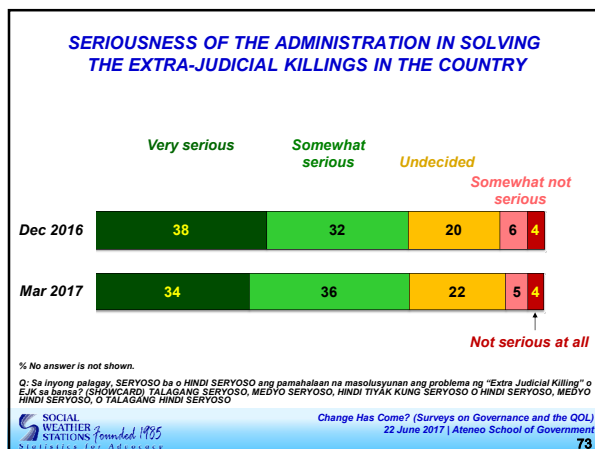
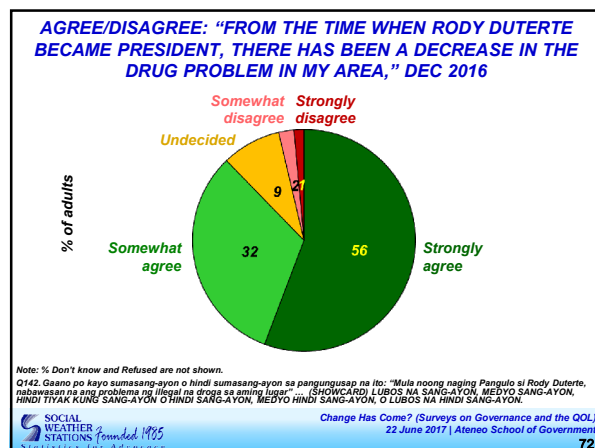
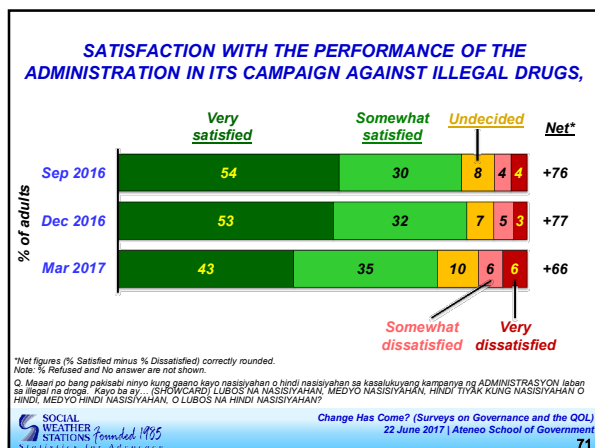


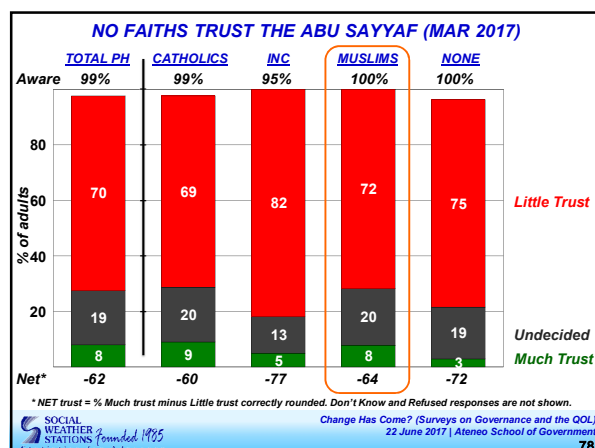
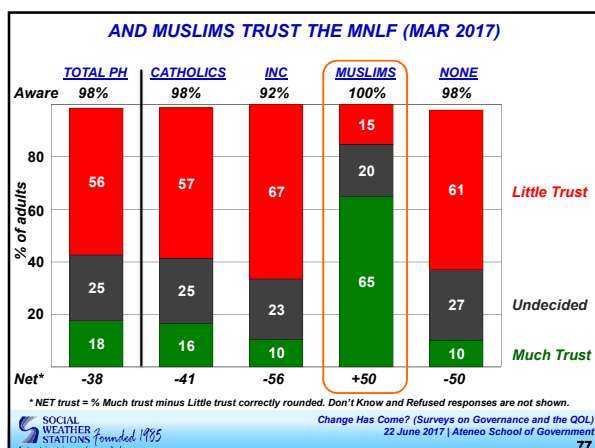












### SUMMARY-1

- 1 Public Morale: Very high since 2010

degrees; Muslims trust the MILF and MNLF,
